Catholic Schools Week dress code: January 28 through February 1, 2019

- Majestic Monday, Jan. 28- *Dress like a royal (past or present)- or wear royal colors like purple or red or gold with jeans. Students who do not participate in theme day dress should wear normal school uniform attire.*
- Tacky Tuesday, Jan. 29- *Wear mis-matched or clashing crazy colored clothing-like ugly sweater day but it doesn't have to be Christmas. Students who do not participate in theme day dress should wear normal school uniform attire.*
