Opening of School

The first day of school is Monday, August 21, for all students in 7th through 12th grade. Drop off begins at 7:30 a.m. The first day for our high school and junior high students will be a full day and all students should arrive in their school uniform.

- High School
 - Students should be in their classroom by 8:05 a.m. and dismissed at 3:05 p.m.
- Junior High
 - Students will go to the gym until they are released to their lockers. Their lockers will be the ones closest to the gym area.
 - o Junior high students should be in their classroom by 7:55 a.m. and dismissed at 3:15 p.m.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up

High school students should be dropped off and picked up at the athletic entrance, closest to the gym doors.

Junior High students can use either the front, half circle entrance off of Wieneke Road or the athletic entrance, closest to the gym doors. Students will proceed to the gym as soon as they arrive on campus.

Back to School Paperwork

Annual forms are once again available within <u>Skyward Family Access</u>. Many fields will pull data you have already provided us from Skyward, but others will require your attention. A form tutorial and helpful Skyward links can be found on our website at <u>Skyward Support</u>. Forms will need to be completed for each student enrolled at Nouvel Catholic Central.

In addition to general forms, athletic forms for 9-12 grade students can also be accessed within Skyward by logging in and selecting "Online Forms" on the navigation menu. We kindly ask that all forms be completed no later than August 31, 2023.
