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Counselor's Corner

Greetings and welcome to the latest edition of the counseling updates. For our morning messages, there was focus again on the power of words and the importance of feeding positive thoughts to grow positive outlooks. There also were messages on empathy and how to show it, & resilience and the importance of getting up from falls and moving forward.

This month our 6th grade students learned about the power that their words have and how we have choices to lift others or bring them down. This continues as we will hear a story and do activities exploring how gossip and rumors spread, affect others, and how hard it is to undo damage. Our younger students learned about making good choices, exploring how our feelings may get big quickly, but we have choices in how we will act on those feelings. We also learned some patterns for how to take a deep breath to get centered and focused. We practiced using breathing balls and they were added to the comfort corners in each of the rooms.

If you have concerns or suggestions of things you would like to see presented or discussed with our students, please feel free to reach out to me. In addition to class lessons, I see students individually or in group settings to help with issues like anger or anxiety, and I can help with conflict resolution when needed. I look forward to continuing to work with our students and helping their social and emotional development.
